What is Sickle Cell Disease?

Sickle cell disease is an inherited blood disorder where red blood cells become rigid and c-shaped, leading to frequent breakdowns and blood vessel blockages. This can cause pain, organ damage, and health issues. Sickle cell disease is a serious condition that can be detrimental to daily and long-term health. Fortunately, modern medical treatments can prevent complications, allowing children to thrive!

Treatment

Children with sickle cell disease are at an increased risk of health complications, making early detection and treatment very important. Research and clinical experience have shown that children cared for in a comprehensive sickle cell center have fewer complications and better quality of life. Our patients are monitored regularly in clinic.

From your first clinic visit, you will work with our team of professionals who are committed to supporting your family's medical and psychosocial needs. As a team, we focus on health maintenance strategies, including:

- Teaching preventive therapies that may help your child avoid symptoms
- Understanding how to recognize the early signs of complications
- Screening for risks of complications
